Urban decoration highly resistant and protective with pedestrians and bicycles, works as traffic aligner, as color posts and we have them in different sizes with reflectives.

These elements are good traffic controllers and guaranteed people safety, while manage the accesses in an agile and practic way.

Its recommended to install them in rows along streets and avenues impeding motorized vehicles enter to only walking areas.

- Minimum maintenance.

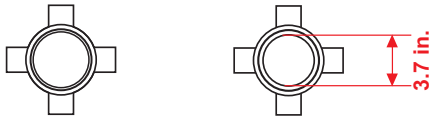

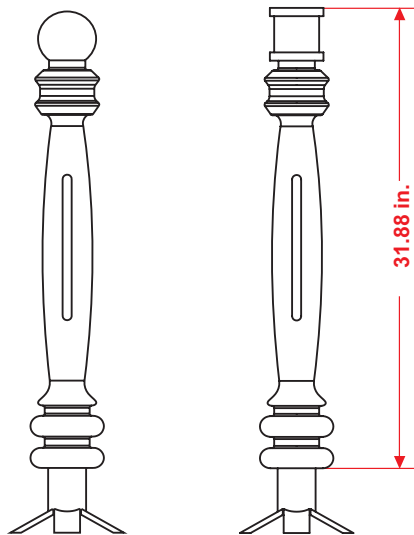

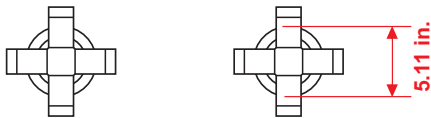
## TOP VIEW

<b>Total</b>	Height: 31.88 in. Width: 5.27 in.
<b>Aprox.weight:</b>	24,16 lb.

First mark the auger ubication, then perforate a hole 10 inches diameter and 9 inches depth with a perforating punch. Clear of dirt the hole as possible and pour the cement mix (previously prepared). Insert just the bollard base, check the level (no more, no less) and fill the rest of the hole to get a good cimentation.
